Therefore, Your Excellency's intervention on behalf of the international community, to protect and defend one of the most important documents of our time, *The Universal Declaration on Human Rights* is needed to save the life of Sayed Perwiz Kambakhsh. His arrest is illegal and an obvious violation of Human Rights.
